Saints of the week.

13th July St Henry

St Henry 973-1024, Duke of Bavaria and later Emperor, a just ruler, humble man of prayer and reformer of the church.

14th July St Camillus de Lellis

St Camillus de Lellis 1550-1614 rough-tempered and a gambler in his early life as a soldier, was converted at the age of twenty –five. Guided by St Philip Neri he became a priest and worked for the sick with two companions. His servants of the Sick prospered and founded hospitals especially where others would not go. Patron of nurses, hospitals and the sick.

15th July St Bonaventure

St Bonaventure 1221-74 born in Tuscany, Minister General of the Franciscans, Cardinal Archbishop of Albano, theologian of the Council of Lyons.

16th July Our Lady of Mount Carmel

The Carmelite communities inherit the early hermits' devotions to Elijah and his solitary prayer, and to Mary under this title of Mount Carmel.
