Welcome back!

It is wonderful to be allowed back to Mass again, Praise the Lord. Please follow the guidelines acting responsibly at all times. Thank you to our stewards who are helping out at this time. It took us by surprise last Wednesday night to read of further restrictions on www.gov.ie as updated that very day. It says, without any advance notice, that the celebration of the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation are not to take place not only during the month of May but June is now included also. We were set to announce 13 separate Confirmation celebrations for June, basically a separate one for each class in keeping with guidelines. Now all this has to be dropped. Children, parents and teachers were informed on Friday and all were terribly disappointed. The government website gives no idea when these restrictions will be lifted so no arrangements can be made at present for the celebration of Confirmation.

The celebration of **Baptism** is available every Saturday and Sunday and up to 10 people may attend. Please contact the parish office for bookings. **Funerals** – 50 mourners permitted at service.
