#### **EUCCHARISTIC STREET BLESSING FOR THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI THURSDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE 2021**

As happened last year, due to the Covid-19 restrictions on public gatherings, the traditional Corpus Christi Procession will be replaced by a **Eucharistic Street Blessing** around Mallow town. Jesus in the Monstrance will be brought around the town in an open roofed car, asking his blessing on all. It will be preceded by another car from which the rosary, prayers, and hymns will be led. You are all invited to stand outside your homes as a mark of respect to Our Lord and Saviour. The Street Blessing will begin at the Church of the Resurrection taking the following route and will end at St Mary's at approximately 8.45 pm with live streamed Benediction on [www.churchservices.tv/mallow](http://www.churchservices.tv/mallow)
