Saints of the Week

16th August

St Stephen of Hungary, 975-1038, first King of Hungary and its patron saint.

Worked for the conversion of his people to Christianity.

17th August

Our Lady of Knock. The story of Knock began on the 21 August 1879 when Our Lady, St Joseph and St John the Evangelist appeared at the south gable of Knock Parish Church. This miraculous apparition was witnessed by fifteen people, young and old. Knock is an internationally recognised Marian Shrine. Saint John Paul II visited Knock as part of his 1979 papal pilgrimage to Ireland. Pope Francis went to Knock and prayed at the Shrine before the final Mass of the World Meeting of Families at the Phoenix Park Dublin, on Sunday 26 August 2018. The date of the memorial is within the annual novena conducted at the Shrine.

20th August

St Bernard, born 1090, died 20 August 1153, became a Cistercian monk at Citeaux in 1113 and was chosen abbot of Clairvaux in 1115. His writings reveal a solid grasp of biblical studies, spiritual theology and philosophy. Patron of Gibraltar and beekeepers.
