4th October

St. Francis of Assisi, 1181-1226, abandoned all things for the love of Christ, founded the Friars Minor, and with St. Clare, the Poor Clares. For the last two years of his life he suffered the stigmata. Patron saint of ecologists.

5th October

St Faustina born near Łódź Poland in 1905, died Kraków in 1938, her short life spent as a Sister of Mercy. She inspired the movement dedicated to proclaiming and imploring Divine Mercy throughout the world.

7th October

Our Lady of the Rosary Today's celebration urges all to meditate on the mysteries of Christ, following the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was in a special manner associated with the incarnation, passion and glorious resurrection of the Son of God.

9th October

St John Henry Newman was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI at Cofton Park, Birmingham, on 19th September 2010 and canonised 13 October 2019. The Church in Ireland is deeply aware of St John Henry's gentle scholarship, deep human wisdom and profound love for the Lord.
