Indulgences for the Holy Souls during November

Due to Covid-19, the Apostolic Penitentiary has extended the possibility to gain the following indulgences applicable only to the souls in purgatory until the end of November—

Plenary Indulgence by visiting a church any day during November this year and praying the "Our Father" and the "Creed" there.

Plenary Indulgence each day by from 1 to 8 November by visiting a cemetery and praying for the deceased (now any 8 days in November).

Those who for serious reasons cannot leave their homes can obtain the plenary indulgence by praying for the deceased before an image of Jesus or Mary.

The usual conditions apply: being in a state of grace, without attachment to sin, receiving Holy Communion on the day, praying for the Pope's intentions, confession within several days before/after.

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven.
