Wednesday 8th December—Feast of the Immaculate Conception, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses as follows:

St Mary's—Vigil of the Feast, Tuesday 6.30 p.m. Feast Day 11.00 a.m. Church of the Resurrection—Feast Day 10.00 a.m. and 7.30 p.m.

9 Day Rosary 30th Nov—8th Dec., 9.p.m. each evening – final Rosary on Radio Maria.

Sunday, 12th December—Bambinelli Blessing.

Over the past number of decades, on the Third Sunday of Advent, children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figurines (Bambinelli) from their homes to St. Peter's Square where they are blessed by the Pope.

All children and families are invited to bring the 'Baby Jesus' figurine from their cribs at home to be blessed at all Mallow Masses, on the Third Sunday of Advent (11th/12th December).

Following the blessing, families take their 'bambino' home, wrap it and as a family open that parcel first on Christmas morning and the youngest member of the family would place it in the crib. A gift of the presence of Christ in the home this Christmas.
