Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Monday to Saturday from after 10 a.m. Mass until 6 p.m. at present. Perhaps later closing in the Summer. For the safety of everybody, only 6 people will be allowed in the Adoration Chapel at any one time. **Entry will be from the church only.** The curtain will be drawn back and one pew in the church will be turned facing the Monstrance. Adorers in pre-covid times are asked to please contact the coordinators to commit to an hour or if you are unable to continue, please inform them so that an hour will not be left unattended. We thank all the people down through the years who consistently spent an hour in Adoration of the Lord, especially during night hours. May He bless you in every way.
