CONFIRMATION IN MALLOW ON TUESDAY 26TH APRIL.

The 9.15 a.m. Mass in the Church of the Resurrection will be at 8.30 a.m. on Tuesday 26th April.

We meet God in many ways, but the sacraments are special ways in which we meet Jesus. For each of the seven sacraments there is something visible pointing beyond itself and there is an accompanying prayer. In Confirmation, it is the bishop anointing on the forehead with the oil of chrism and the prayer is, "Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit." Each sacrament gives us a grace that we receive only in that sacrament. The sacrament of Confirmation completes the grace we received in the Sacrament of Baptism and gives us the mission of witnessing publicly to Jesus. Just how important the sacrament of Confirmation is for us can be seen in that if a child is in danger of death, a priest will confirm that child. Three sacraments leave a permanent mark on our souls and so we receive those sacraments only once: the sacrament of Baptism, the sacrament of Confirmation, and for priests the Sacrament of Holy Orders in which they are ordained priests.
