Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are lay people who distribute Holy Communion during Mass. They are *extraordinary* because the ordinary minister of Holy Communion is a bishop, priest, or deacon. We call them Extraordinary Ministers of *Holy Communion* rather than Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist because “of the Eucharist” would refer to ministering during the entire Mass as do bishops, priests, and deacons. For brevity, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are often known simply as Extraordinary Ministers.

All Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are asked to be present at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday in St. Mary's or Church of the Resurrection to be recommissioned. New Extraordinary Ministers will also be commissioned at the same time.

An acolyte is also an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. From 1972, being instituted as an acolyte has been a step for a seminarian on the road to priesthood. From 1983, the ministry of acolyte was broadened to men who were not seminarians, and in January this year Pope Francis broadened it to include women also. Acolytes are instituted by the bishop during Mass.
