In the Old Testament, Eve is called “the woman.” The word “Eve” in Hebrew means “mother of life”. So “the woman” was the mother of life. As Jesus on the cross gave Mary to John as mother, and to us as spiritual Mother, he addressed her as “woman” (John 19:26). This title “woman” parallels and contrasts Mary with Eve, the woman of the Old Covenant. Mary, the first woman of the New Covenant to believe in Jesus, became our spiritual Mother as Jesus was about to expire.
