Holy Water

We bless ourselves and our homes with Holy Water. There are different options for the priest to bless Holy Water, and we can see its power in the words of the priest's blessing, parts of which are the following:

Almighty ever-living God . . . bless this water . . .
and grant that by this water we may be defended
from all ills of spirit and body.

or

Almighty Lord and God . . .
bless this water,
which we use in confidence
to implore forgiveness for our sins
and to obtain the protection of your grace
against all illness and every snare of the enemy.

When the priest blesses salt and mixes it with the water, this is part of the prayer:
We humbly ask you, Almighty God . . . to bless this salt . . . that wherever this mixture
of salt and water is sprinkled,
every attack of the enemy may be repulsed.
