Westminster Hall

Westminster Hall, where the late Queen Elizabeth II is currently lying in state, has witnessed very important historical events. It saw the trials and condemnations to death of St. Thomas More and St. John Cardinal Fisher. John Fisher was the only English bishop to stand up for the Church and remain entirely faithful to the Catholic Church during the reign of King Henry VIII. When Pope Benedict XVI visited the UK in 2010 he gave an address in Westminster Hall (17th September 2010) in which he urged to allow faith shed light on political decisions. Pope Benedict said, "Religion, in other words, is not a problem for legislators to solve, but a vital contributor to the national conversation" and "the world of reason and the world of faith – the world of secular rationality and the world of religious belief – need one another and should not be afraid to enter into a profound and ongoing dialogue, for the good of our civilization."
