Indulgences for the Holy Souls.

From 12.00 noon, on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory and there, reciting one Our Father and the Apostles Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within about 20 days before or after 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st to 8th November. For every other visit to a church made during this time, a partial Indulgence for the same intention may be gained.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a Plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1—8 November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.

NOVEMBER - MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS.

November is a special time to remember to pray for our dead. Each Priest in the Parish celebrates twelve Masses for the Holy Souls annually. Envelopes with forms to include names of your departed loved ones are available at the back of both churches. We invite you to take an envelope. Please return completed list and offering to the collection box at Mass. Alternatively hand in to the Parish Office or to any one of the Priest's houses. The lists of all deceased will be placed in front of the altar and they will be remembered at all Masses during November.
