### VISIT OF THE RELICS OF ST BERNADETTE

The relics of St Bernadette of Lourdes will visit the Diocese of Cloyne on September 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. The relics will be in St Mary's Church, Mallow on Sunday, 15<sup>th</sup> September and at the Church of the Most Holy Rosary, Middleton on Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> September. This very special, once-in-a-lifetime event will provide an opportunity for people of all ages and backgrounds to experience the special gifts and charisms of Lourdes. The visitation of the holy relics is an opportunity to bring Lourdes to our diocese, benefiting those who may not be able to travel to Lourdes themselves by sharing in some of the atmosphere of prayer and consolation that pilgrims experience while they are there. This will provide a glimpse of what is near and dear to the hearts of those who travel on our diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes each year. Bernadette Soubirous was born into a poor but loving family in 1844. In 1858 she saw the Virgin Mary eighteen times at the Grotto of Massabielle. The apparitions of Lourdes were authenticated in 1866 by the Bishop of Tarbes. In that same year, Bernadette left Lourdes to live out her religious vocation within the community of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. She died at the age of 35 and was proclaimed Blessed in 1925, and then a saint in 1933.
