#### THE PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

Sometimes one hears the Church being referred to as a 'club' that has rules its members must follow. In many ways this is a crude and reductive way of describing things, but in another way it has its uses. There are indeed certain things Catholics are required to do if their membership of the Church is to have any real meaning and be more than ticking a box on the census. These are set out in the Church's Precepts. While there is a lot more to living the fulness of the Christian life to which we are called, these things at least represent the basics and what will keep us united to the life of the Church, especially in times when we're not particularly 'feeling it'. They are:

- You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labour.
- You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- You shall receive Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter Season.
- You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence prescribed by the Church.
- You shall help to provide for the material needs of the Church according to your ability.
