NOVENA PRAYERS TO OUR LADY OF KNOCK 13 – 21 AUGUST

The apparition of the Lamb of God surrounded by angels, Our Lady, St Joseph and St John took place at Knock on 21st August 1879. The novena to our Lady of Knock is celebrated each year at Knock Shrine from 13-21 August. We may join ourselves spiritually to these nine days of prayer by reciting the novena prayers each day. Daily Rosary or Mass and Holy Communion are also recommended.
