As a voluntary organization, almost all our funding relies on local donations – through church gate collections, one-off contributions, bequests, and the proceeds of our Vincent's shop. *On behalf of those we serve, we deeply appreciate your ongoing generosity.*

SVP's central mission is *to support the needy and vulnerable* within our community, and our only criterion for assistance is genuine **NEED**. This year has seen a significant rise in requests for help, including from low-and middle-income families who are struggling to meet the ever-increasing cost of living. This winter, we expect to assist over 400 families. Your continued donations – either in person or through svp.ie (please specify Mallow SVP) – are vital to this work.

Alongside our core home visitation service, through which we provide material support to those in need, we operate a food bank supporting up to 100 families weekly. We are also placing greater emphasis on supporting education, believing it to be key to breaking generational poverty. In response to the national housing crisis, SVP Mallow also plans, with Government support, to expand our Social Housing programme, with an ambitious plan to build more apartments beyond our existing ten units.
