The Easter Octave begins on Easter Sunday and ends on the Second Sunday of Easter, with every day in between being considered as an extension of Easter Sunday itself. The Easter Octave takes precedence over any other feasts on the calendar. At Mass on each of these days the Gospel recounts one of the appearances of the Risen Lord to his disciples, the Gloria is said, the Easter Sequence may be recited and the dismissal at the end of Mass concludes with a double 'alleluia'.
