THE LIFE OF THE HOLY TRINITY IN 'CHRIST IN HIS MYSTERIES' BY BLESSED COLUMBA MARMION
What does faith tell us? That there are in God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; three distinct Persons in one and the same unity of nature.

As you know, the Father does not proceed from anyone; He is the Wellspring without Wellspring, the first Source of all the interior life in God, the first Origin of all the ineffable communications within the Trinity. Knowing Himself, the Father begets by and Infinite Word one unique and perfect Son, to whom He communicates all that He is, except the property of being Father, which is personal to himself: "As the Father has life in Himself, even so he has given to the Son also to have life in Himself." (John 5:26) The Son is equal in everything to the Father; he is the congruent expression, the perfect image, of the Father; He possesses with him the same divine nature. The Father and the Son give themselves, each to the other, with a perfect love, and it is from this giving of love, by the Father to the Son and the Son to the Father, that, in a mysterious way, there proceeds the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Trinity. The Holy Spirit closes the cycle of the interior processes in God; He is the completion of the divine communications within the adorable Trinity.

As you know also, there is between these distinct Persons no superiority or inferiority; it would be a serious error to suppose such a thing. All three are equal in power, in wisdom, in goodness, because all three possess equally, in an indivisible manner, one and the same divine nature with all its infinite perfections. And that is why all our praise is addressed, at the same time, to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.
